Judge: Mobile home residents can stay for now

Residents of the park were hoping the judge would rule against the evictions in court Thursday, but the decision only keeps them in their home until after the holidays.

“At least I can tell my kids that we can finish decorating the Christmas tree and that Santa Claus will know where to find us,” said Dawn St. Clair. “But it's still heartbreaking that come Jan. 11, I have nowhere to put them.”

An attorney for the landlord did not return a call from **News 12** to comment.
